BookSafe is a book manager for iPhone, iPad and Apple Watch: scan books by ISBN, track your reading, stay on top of series. What sets it apart from Goodreads and StoryGraph: **no account, no tracking, no third-party servers.** Data lives on the device and syncs only through the user's own private iCloud. Built by a family in southern Germany.

FIVE KEY FEATURES

Add books in seconds

Scan an ISBN and title, author, cover and publisher arrive automatically. CSV import handles Goodreads exports.

From reading day to reading year

Daily page, reading sessions with a timer, statistics, a yearly challenge — and at year's end, a year in review as a film.

Wishlist, countdown and library loans

A widget counts down the days to release; borrowed books carry a countdown that reminds you before they are due back.

Start from your wrist

New in 1.1: start a reading session on Apple Watch — even with no iPhone in range.

Series that finally add up

Volume numbers from several library catalogues — special volumes such as “book 8.5” included.

PRIVACY — THE FACTS

“Data Not Collected.”

App Store privacy label

- **No user account**, no sign-up, no email address.
- **No analytics SDK**, no ad network, no third-party frameworks.
- Sync through **Apple's CloudKit** in the private iCloud — no developer access.
- Outgoing connections only for book metadata — carrying the **ISBN, never a user identifier.**
- **Export any time** as CSV or PDF.
- No in-app review prompt.

A note for quoting: BookSafe is not “end-to-end encrypted”, and as of 1.0 it is no longer “fully offline” either. The accurate phrasing is: no third-party servers, only your own private iCloud, works offline.
